This year's greatest victory is one we all celebrate: America 250. What the Founders established has endured because patriots like you, across generations, have refused to let freedom fade.

Through your support of the ACLU, liberty is protected, life is defended, and the Constitution still stands strong. *Freedom is flourishing — because you continue the fight.*

ACLU Wins Major FBI Whistleblower Case

The ACLU secured full vindication for FBI Special Agent Garret O'Boyle through a DOJ settlement restoring his back pay, benefits, and security clearance, plus reinstatement and damages. After exposing the FBI's targeting of pro-lifers, O'Boyle faced retaliation. This victory reverses that injustice, protects whistleblowers and free speech, and signals that government weaponization against those who reveal wrongdoing will not stand. Thanks to you, constitutional governance prevails!

Supreme Court Sides With ACLU, Affirms Election Integrity

The Supreme Court delivered a resounding victory for election integrity in *Bost v. Illinois State Board of Elections*. In a majority decision, the Court vindicated the ACLU's amicus brief

in this case, where we stood as guardians of constitutional liberties and the fundamental principle that Election Day means Election Day. Your support helped win this fight for every American voter.

Unanimous Supreme Court Victory To Protect Pro-Life Centers

In *First Choice Women's Resource Centers v. Davenport*, the Justices ruled that pregnancy centers can challenge government investigations in federal court *before* irreversible harm occurs. Government officials can no longer use subpoenas and delay tactics to silence pro-life centers with impunity. The First Amendment won yet again — because you stood with us.

Supreme Court to Cities Everywhere: Evangelism Can't Be Sidelined

Gabriel Olivier had been arrested simply for preaching the Gospel on a public sidewalk. Yet the Justices agreed with the arguments in our amicus brief, ruling that preachers can challenge unconstitutional laws — even after a conviction. *Olivier v. City of Brandon* is more than a win for one preacher. It is a victory for the rule of law, for civil rights litigators, and for every ACLU client and supporter who refuses to let hostile governments silence the Gospel.

MOMENTOUS ABORTION DEFUNDING VICTORY

After seven amicus briefs and battles on three simultaneous legal fronts — Massachusetts, Maine, and California — the abortion lobby's effort to legally force taxpayer funding of Planned Parenthood has completely collapsed. A coalition of 22 pro-abortion states walked away with nothing. Your support made it possible — brief by brief, battle by battle.

This is indeed a landmark victory. **But the fight isn't over.** The "Big Beautiful Bill" only restricted abortion funding for one year. By the time you read this, taxpayer funding of Planned Parenthood will be reinstated. The only way to make this permanent is through Congress. The ACLJ will be at the forefront of this fight, just as we have been at every stage that has brought us to today. *God bless you for standing with us!*

You and the ACLJ: Standing for Life at the Supreme Court of the United States

For 36 years, the ACLJ has stood at the forefront of the legal battle to defend life — protecting the unborn, safeguarding pro-life speech, and defending the ministries and medical professionals who serve women with compassion and conviction. From our **9-0 Supreme Court victory** helping protect pro-life pregnancy centers from government coercion to our critical fight against the expansion of **abortion pill access**, the ACLJ has shaped the national legal landscape on life for decades.

But in the post-*Roe* era, the battle has intensified. The abortion industry, radical activists, and hostile government officials are working aggressively to erase every protection for the unborn and silence every voice that stands for life. That is why your support is indispensable. *Because of you, the ACLJ is fighting — and winning — on every front.*

Defending Pro-Life Pregnancy Centers

Across the country, pro-life pregnancy centers

are being targeted with censorship, investigations, and unconstitutional mandates. In Massachusetts, New York, and nationally, we are confronting the systematic censorship of these safe havens.

Because of your support, these organizations continue their vital work — and their doors remain open.

Ending Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

Taxpayer dollars should never fund the abortion industry. The ACLJ continues to lead the charge to permanently defund Planned Parenthood and stop federal agencies from using public money to destroy human embryos. The past year brought major victories: Planned Parenthood dropped lawsuits, states dismissed abortion-funding cases after our briefs were submitted, and we filed our seventh amicus brief in a massive multistate battle to keep taxpayer dollars from supporting abortion. **Your commitment is helping cut off the financial lifeline of the abortion industry.**

Fighting for Life in States and Cities

The most extreme attacks on life are emerging at the state and local levels, and the ACLJ is there to respond. We successfully opposed a Maryland bill that would shield infanticide from investigation. We confronted a Colorado abortionist attempting to cut parents out of minors' abortion decisions. We secured a major victory when a court dismissed a radical



lawsuit seeking to overturn Missouri's parental consent law. And we are battling unconstitutional mandates in Illinois and Philadelphia that attempt to force pro-life pregnancy centers to promote abortion. **Your support ensures that life is defended where the stakes are highest.**

Protecting Pro-Life Americans and Medical Professionals

No American should be punished for defending life or living out their faith. Yet pro-life advocates are being arrested, silenced, and targeted. The ACLJ defends those wrongly charged, exposing the DOJ's weaponization of the FACE Act and holding cities accountable when officials admit they shut down pro-life speech "because of the message." We are also defending physicians forced out of their positions for refusing to participate in abortions. **Your support protects the rights of every American who stands for life.**

As America celebrates 250 years of liberty, the fight for life remains central to our identity as a nation. And because of you, the ACLJ is ensuring that the next 250 years remain rooted in the truth that every life is precious.



IN MASSACHUSETTS ... AND BEYOND: WE WON'T BE INTIMIDATED INTO SILENCE!

An extraordinary coalition of organizations has filed friend-of-the-court (amicus curiae) briefs in support of our client and against Massachusetts' attack on pro-life pregnancy centers.

Friend-of-the-court briefs are more than legal filings. They are a declaration. Each of these organizations took the time, marshaled the resources, and put its name on the line to tell the First Circuit Court of Appeals that what happened in Massachusetts is not just one clinic's problem — it is a constitutional threat to all of us. When the state can brand a pro-life ministry "dangerous," bury it in subpoenas, and fund a campaign to drive it out of existence, no American's freedom of speech, religion, or association is safe.

We are humbled and energized by the outpouring of support ... and will keep fighting this case to the finish line. With allies like you and this coalition beside us, we are more confident than ever that the First Amendment will prevail — and that life will be defended.

GUARDING INDEPENDENCE FROM GOVERNMENT TYRANNY

Government overreach was the very spark that drove our Founding Fathers to declare independence 250 years ago. When they later drafted the Constitution, they designed it not to *grant* rights but to *limit government's intrusion* on the God-given rights we already possess.

The ACLJ has become a modern bulwark against unconstitutional power grabs — ensuring our government stays in its proper place and liberty endures.

Defending the Constitutional Separation of Powers

The Constitution has served as a guardrail against concentrated power since America's founding — yet today, activist judges and unelected officials increasingly attempt to rewrite the limits placed upon them. The ACLJ is pushing back, defending the separation of powers as our Founders planned.

- **Stopping Rogue Judicial Overreach** — The ACLJ is fighting back after an activist judge exceeded her authority and prevented DOGE officials in the Treasury Department from accessing the sensitive data necessary to monitor for fraud and abuse.
- **Federal Court Ends Discriminatory DEI Programs** — In a resounding victory

for equal treatment under the law, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit upheld President Trump's Executive orders to dismantle discriminatory Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) programs in the federal government and federal contracting. The court's ruling affirms that the President has the constitutional authority to end race-based preferences that violate fundamental civil rights protections.

- **Challenging Judicial Power Grabs in the D.C. Circuit** — The ACLJ is confronting judges who have attempted to insert themselves into core Executive functions, reinforcing that courts cannot assume powers the Constitution does not grant them. We are also filing briefs to defend the President's authority to implement the Hyde Amendment.

Restoring Transparency and Accountability

A government that operates in the shadows is a government unrestrained. Through one of the most robust Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) practices in the nation, the ACLJ is exposing corruption, uncovering political targeting, and forcing federal agencies to answer to the American people — just as the Founders intended.



- **Exposing “Arctic Frost” Targeting of Conservatives** — The ACLJ filed a major lawsuit to unearth a secretive federal program allegedly used to surveil and target conservative Americans and to demand transparency from agencies that have operated without oversight.
- **Uncovering Massive Fraud in Minnesota** — Through aggressive FOIA requests, the ACLJ is shedding light on the Walz administration’s mishandling of billions in taxpayer funds, revealing systemic failures and demanding accountability for one of the largest fraud scandals in state history.
- **Vindicating FBI Whistleblower Garret O’Boyle** — After the Biden FBI retaliated against a whistleblower who exposed internal abuses of power, the ACLJ represented him — leading to a massive settlement from the DOJ and a complete vindication of his rights.

When the government oversteps, patriots don’t sit on the sidelines. Your support empowers the ACLJ to confront unconstitutional power grabs, defend the rule of law, and hold our leaders accountable.

You preserve the blessings of liberty — not just for today but for future generations, *your children and grandchildren*, who will one day inherit the America we are defending together.

STANDING WITH ISRAEL AGAINST ENEMIES OF FREEDOM

For decades, the ACLJ has been unwavering in its commitment to defend our esteemed Middle East ally's legitimacy and right to exist.

In recent years, Israel's necessary actions against Hamas, Iran, and hostile forces in Lebanon have opened the door to a new wave of lawfare — coordinated efforts to undermine Israel's right to exist, distort its actions on the world stage, and drag the Jewish state before hostile international courts.

With unmatched experience in international law, the ACLJ is uniquely positioned to confront these battles head-on. Through every challenge — in courtrooms, at the United Nations (U.N.), and in the halls of government — ACLJ members like you have empowered a defense of Israel that is principled, powerful, and persistent.

Our Ongoing Work Together

- A legal team on the ground in Jerusalem — every single day. Our Jerusalem office works daily to defend Israel's very right to exist. Because the sun never sets on the dangers Israel faces, our work never stops.
- Engaging in major federal lawsuits to defend Israel's legal standing. Israel's enemies are attempting to erase its identity

as a Jewish state through litigation. We are fully engaged in federal courts to stop these attacks before they take root.

- **Confronting Israel's adversaries at the U.N., ICC, and ICJ.** From hostile resolutions to baseless war-crimes accusations, we are defending Israel in the very forums where its enemies seek to isolate and condemn it.
- **Submitting written and oral arguments** on issues ranging from Israel's security to the protection of Christian communities across the Middle East.

Defending Israel in Domestic Courts, International Courts, and at the U.N.

- **Stopping a Federal Judge From Stripping Presidential Power.** A federal judge attempted to block the President's constitutional authority to defend Israel. The ACLJ intervened with major amicus briefs filed at multiple levels to protect the Executive branch's ability to stand with our ally.

Standing for Israel at the United Nations

- **Affirming Israel's Legal Right To Defend Itself Against Iran** — through a



critical presentation to the United Nations.

- **Exposing the False Charge of “Genocide”** — and revealing the political motives behind the claim.
- **Putting the U.N. Lawfare Regime on Notice** — that its coordinated attacks on Israel violate international norms and fuel global antisemitism.

★★★ **Securing the Release of Israeli Hostages**

Few battles are more urgent than the fight to bring hostages home. From the earliest days following the October 7 Hamas-led attacks, the ACLJ advocated relentlessly to secure the release of innocent Israelis held by terrorists.

- **Demanding International Action at the U.N.** We called on the United Nations to demand Hamas release all hostages immediately and dismantle its terror networks.
- **Representing Hostage Families and Securing Freedom.** After more than two years in captivity, surviving hostages — including six ACLJ clients — were finally released. A testament to the ACLJ’s relentless international advocacy through strategic legal filings with the U.N. and bold, personal appeals before the U.N. Human Rights Council.



ACLJ’S BATTLE AGAINST ANTISEMITISM

This year, the ACLJ secured a major victory when a New York law school was forced to remove antisemitic social media posts. We also defended a Jewish parent whose free-speech rights were violated, and challenged a court decision that allowed antisemitism to flourish on campus.

Across the country, ACLJ members like you are helping ensure that America remains a place where antisemitism is confronted, Jewish students and parents are protected, and the promise of liberty is upheld for all.

To Secure the Blessings of Liberty ...

From the very beginning, America was built on a single, immovable pillar: **religious freedom**.

It was one of the reasons patriots gathered in secret meeting houses, pledged their lives and fortunes to one another, and ultimately signed their names to the Declaration of Independence — *knowing full well it could cost them everything*.

They believed that freedom was endowed by God Himself. And they enshrined this truth in the very architecture of our Republic.

Yet today, faith and freedom face some of the greatest threats in our nation's history. **The next 250 years of American liberty depend on our willingness, together, to defend these cornerstones now.**

This year, you and the ACLJ have protected teachers, preachers, students, employees, and everyday believers from discrimination and government overreach. And as the assaults on constitutional freedom and religious liberty intensify, our commitment remains unshakable:

To defend independence from tyranny ... and your right to live out your faith boldly and publicly ... just as the Founders intended.

Landmark Victories

**Unanimous Supreme Court:
Evangelism Cannot Be Sidelined**

In a sweeping 9-0 decision, the Supreme Court affirmed what the ACLJ has long argued — cities cannot push evangelism out of public life.

Gabriel Olivier, a street preacher, was told if he wanted to preach the Gospel in the city of Brandon, Mississippi, he needed to keep within the confines of a “protest zone” — limiting where preachers could share their faith. When Mr. Olivier preached on the sidewalks, just as he had done before, he was arrested, charged, and fined. Undeterred, he sued to stop future enforcement of the ordinance so he could return and continue his ministry.

The Fifth Circuit, in a sharply divided 9-8 *en banc* ruling in *Olivier v. City of Brandon*, slammed the door shut. It twisted its jurisprudence to say that because Mr. Olivier had already been convicted by paying the fine, he could never challenge the unconstitutional law.

But the Supreme Court disagreed: Mr. Olivier wasn't attacking his past conviction; he sought only prospective relief, an injunction stopping future enforcement so he could keep preaching. The Supreme Court held that such a distinction matters, and paying a fine cannot permanently bar someone from challenging an unconstitutional law going forward.

It's clear: Sharing one's faith is a protected expression at the very heart of the First Amendment. **The Gospel cannot be regulated away.**

Protecting a Teacher's Right To Pray

A federal appeals court delivered a sweeping victory for religious liberty, affirming that a public school teacher cannot be punished for quietly living out

her faith.

After she was reprimanded simply for praying during her personal time, the ACLJ stepped in, arguing that the First Amendment protects her right to express her beliefs without fear of retaliation.

The court agreed, reinforcing a truth the Founders understood well: **Faith does not disappear when you enter public service.**

Defending Religious Liberty

Standing Against California's Targeting of Churches

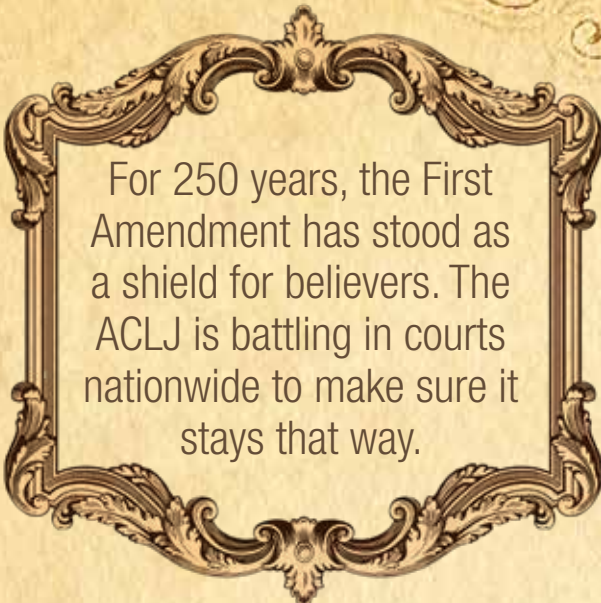
We are representing Calvary Chapel at the U.S. Supreme Court to expose Governor Gavin Newsom's unconstitutional targeting of religious gatherings and defending the right of churches to worship freely.

We have petitioned the Court to take this case, as it underscores a truth the Founders knew well: **Government has no authority to decide when or how Americans may gather to worship.**

Holding Chicago Accountable for Trying To Silence the Gospel

We are challenging Chicago's unlawful arrests of Christian preachers and exposing the city's efforts to hide its unconstitutional actions in this ongoing case.

Our work is forcing Chicago to answer for its violations — because **no city is above the Constitution, and no official may silence religious speech without consequence.**

In a nation where blasphemy laws are routinely weaponized against believers, these men have endured years of isolation, fear, and injustice. Yet they remain steadfast in their faith, and we remain steadfast in our commitment to help them.

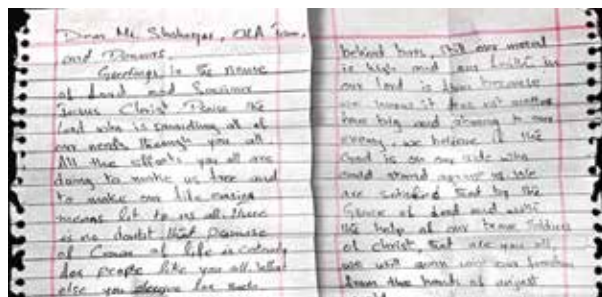
This year, ACLJ Senior Counsel Shaheryar Gill traveled to Pakistan's death-row facility to meet our clients face to face — a rare and extraordinary moment of hope for men who have spent years cut off from the outside world. He sat with them, prayed with them, and assured them that they are not forgotten.

Read a copy of a handwritten note one of the brothers gave to Shaheryar — a message of gratitude, courage, and unshakable faith written from a death row cell. It stands as a

powerful reminder of why this work matters so deeply and why we cannot stop.

Through your support, the ACLJ is providing legal representation, filing critical appeals, and applying international pressure to overturn these unjust convictions. This is life-and-death advocacy — defending families, restoring hope, and standing with persecuted Christians who have no one else to speak for them.

Even on death row, their faith has not wavered. And neither will our fight for their freedom.

This year, we completed Universal Periodic Review (UPR) filings for every nation in the



world — a historic milestone years in the making. Through these filings and our U.N. submissions, we expose persecution and human rights abuses and demand accountability for nations targeting Christians, from Nigeria to Iran, Somalia, and beyond.

Forcing Accountability in Nigeria

We're documenting atrocities and pressing global leaders to confront the genocide of Christians in Nigeria. As violence escalates, we demand justice and accountability for the tens of thousands murdered since 2009.

Advocating for Persecuted Christians in Congo

This year, Jordan Sekulow personally delivered an urgent message before the U.N. Human Rights Council, and we also engaged U.S. leaders — including Secretary of State Marco Rubio — calling for immediate action to stop the horrific slaughter of Christian communities in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

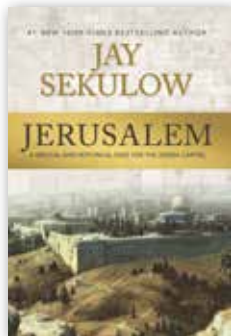

Thank you for standing with us — and with them. Their lives depend on it.

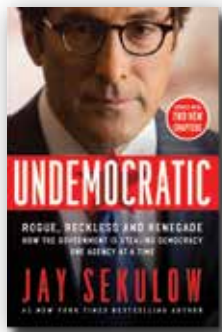

EXPENSES 2025

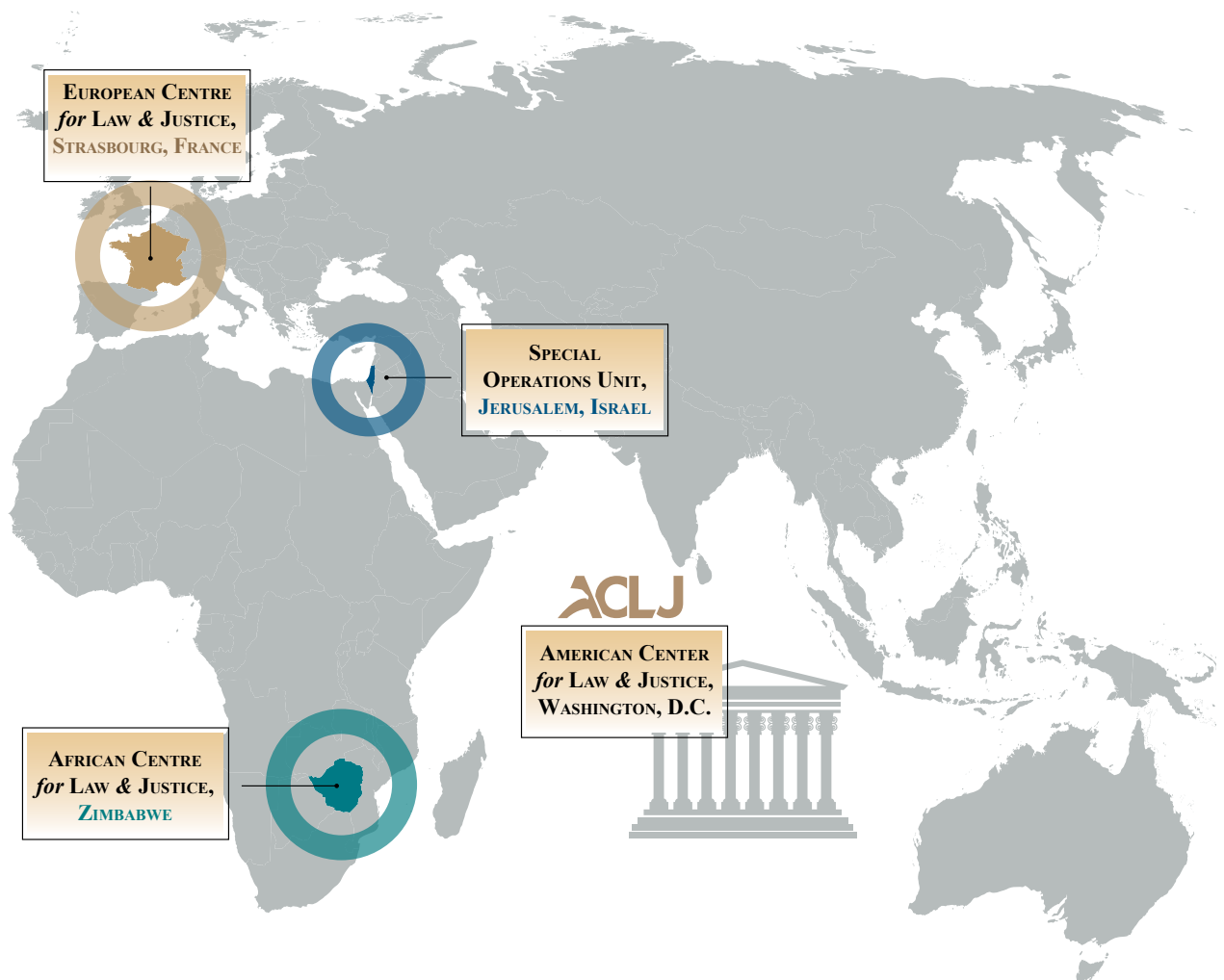
