
From Chief Counsel Jay Alan Sekulow

Dear Friend & Fellow Member of the ACLJ.


How do you define an amazing, challenging, unprecedented, unpredictable, inspiring, victorious, and overwhelming year with one word? HISTORIC.

Your Right To Pray Upheld at Supreme Court

When a Christian high school football coach was fired from his job — his First Amendment rights stripped away — for praying on the field after games, the ACLJ got involved. We filed an amicus brief at the Supreme Court of the United States to protect the constitutional right to pray. The high Court ruled in our favor!

Victory for Families in Major Supreme Court Win: Carson v. Makin

The Supreme Court has once again sided



with the ACLJ in a school choice case! In *Carson v. Makin*, a case in which we appeared as an amicus, the Justices ruled that state-funded tuition assistance programs cannot exclude religious schools.

Supreme Court Protects First Amendment

Supreme Court Justices have ruled that California's Donor Disclosure law violates the First Amendment. The ACLJ filed two critical amicus briefs in this case, and ultimately the Court agreed: being a donor to a conservative charity should not subject you to harassment.

ACLJ Wins Mandate Case at Supreme Court

In a major victory for the ACLJ and the American worker, the Supreme Court issued an emergency stay that blocked President Biden's vaccine mandate. It was an honor to score this win for The Heritage Foundation, in its first lawsuit as a petitioner in federal court, and for your freedom.

Biden's Unconstitutional Overreach Stopped

The ACLJ filed an amicus brief at the district court level against the Biden Administration's attempt through the sixth COVID-19 stimulus bill to take away states' abilities to cut or ban taxes. The court agreed with our argument and deemed the tax cut ban unconstitutional.

Ridiculous Workplace Rule Reversed

A Messianic Jewish worker was told

to remove a sign with the words *Shabbat Shalom* in Hebrew — a traditional Jewish greeting and symbol of



peace — from his personal workstation. He contacted the ACLJ, and we provided him with a personalized legal letter explaining his rights. He took our letter to the company's general manager, who promptly restored his right to keep his religious sign at work.





Deep State IRS Rejected in Court

We filed a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) demand requesting all records pertaining to the IRS's decision refusing tax-exempt status to a religious organization, Christians Engaged. Our FOIA request was continuously ignored — so we filed suit. The judge rejected the IRS's Motion to Dismiss. Now, our case will proceed, just as the law allows.

Pro-Life Beliefs Protected in the Workplace

Our legal team has recently been able to help:

- 1. A nurse who was instructed not to talk about abortion in the workplace because it made some doctors feel uncomfortable,
- 2. A pharmacist who was told she had no legal right to opt out of filling prescriptions for abortifacient drugs,
- 3. And a nurse who was ordered to participate in any and all medical procedures because she's "just a nurse" and has no say.



situations resulted in a pro-life medical professional being able to keep their job while continuing to give witness to the sanctity of human life.



SPOTLIGHT ON HISTORY

1987 — Jay Sekulow wins first case before the U.S. Supreme Court

In the first of what has become a long career of successful cases before the Supreme Court of the United States, Jay Sekulow won a unanimous victory for religious free speech rights in Board of Airport Commissioners v. Jews for Jesus. The unanimous decision in favor of Sekulow's client, Jews for Jesus, began what has now become a fixture of First Amendment jurisprudence — religious speech is given the same protection as all other protected speech — and paved the way for the founding of the American Center for Law and Justice in 1990.

Roe v. Wade Overturned at the Supreme Court of the United States

"Roe was egregiously wrong from the start. Its reasoning was exceptionally weak, and the decision has had damaging consequences. Far from bringing about a national settlement of the abortion issue, Roe and Casey have enflamed debate and deepened division. It is time to heed the Constitution and return the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives."

The *Dobbs* ruling relied in part on two cases Chief Counsel Jay Sekulow personally argued before the Supreme Court decades ago — *Bray v. Alexandria Women's Health Clinic* (which he argued twice: once in 1991 and once in 1992) and *Hill v. Colorado* (2000). The fact that the Court invoked these cases in one of the most significant Supreme Court rulings in history is a testament to your membership's legacy and your dedication to life and liberty.





We did this! The ACLJ's Efforts + Your Support + God's Grace = Historic Victory for Life

1991 – 1992: Bray v. Alexandria Women's Health Clinic

Jay Sekulow successfully argued this case twice before the Supreme Court, resulting in a key victory for the rights of pro-life Americans. This victory later became instrumental in *Dobbs*'s repudiation of any "right" to abortion.



2000: Hill v. Colorado

Another significant ACLJ case! While the decision was a temporary defeat for free speech, the *Dobbs* Court used it as an illustration of *Roe v. Wade*'s "distortion" of the First Amendment. By fighting *Hill* all the way to the Supreme Court, we set up the irony of one bad ruling (*Hill*) being used against another bad ruling (*Roe*) and in the process having the one bad ruling (*Hill*) be effectively renounced.



2022: Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization

Three separate amicus briefs filed in *Dobbs* — the most the ACLJ has ever filed in a single Supreme Court case.

Protecting Pro-Life Speech

Planned Parenthood and the abortion industry want to silence you. One way is to

Conscience Rights

Can your employer force you to participate in an abortion? Can you be fired or sued for refusing to fill a prescription for abortion-inducing drugs? We're involved in several instances to protect the rights of pro-life doctors, nurses, and pharmacists who have been tricked or coerced into providing abortion services or threatened with termination for acting according to their conscience.







Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Prior to the Supreme Court's ruling in *Dobbs*, Planned Parenthood aborted more than 354,000 innocent babies each year.



In fact, the abortion provider was responsible for about 40% of all abortions in the United States. And it takes almost \$1.7

million of our tax dollars every day. Planned Parenthood and the bloated abortion industry don't need taxpayer dollars. We're fighting in Congress, in federal court, and at the Supreme Court to see your tax dollars stripped from abortion funding once and for all.

Exposing the Truth About Abortion

We continue to represent a former board member of the Center for Medical Progress (CMP), who exposed the truth about Planned Parenthood's scheme to sell the body parts of aborted babies for profit. In a terribly flawed ruling, the defendants were ordered to pay millions. We presented oral arguments against this ruling in April 2022. We are hopeful the court will overturn the flawed jury verdict. If not, we are prepared to take this case to the Supreme Court.

The ACLJ is deeply engaged in many battles for your constitutional freedoms and religious liberties as the targeting and censoring of conservative, pro-life voices in our nation intensifies. We fight across many platforms, at many levels — in states, in courtrooms, in Congress, and at the Supreme Court — to ensure you and your family are protected. Freedom is under attack now more than ever ...

The "Disinformation Governance Board"

The Biden Administration announced the creation of the new "Disinformation" review board within the U.S. Department of



Homeland Security (DHS), meant to sniff out and shut down any speech the radical Left considers "disinformation or misinformation" and therefore dangerous.

Could they arrest

you? Could they interrogate you? This may be the greatest threat to freedom of speech in the United States we have seen in our lifetime.

The ACLJ is taking legal action. We've submitted an urgent Freedom of Information Act request against President Biden's DHS as he attempts to muzzle anyone through the Disinformation Governance Board who contradicts his radical agenda. The Biden Administration refused to comply, so we took his DHS to federal court in Washington, D.C.

Defending a Church in Federal Court

We filed a lawsuit in federal court to defend

a Virginia church's right to worship and hold services. Prince William County is requiring our client, Alive Church of the Nazarene, to



get a liquor license in order to use its own property. It's blatant religious discrimination, and we won't stand for it. The case is currently before the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit. *Status: Ongoing*

Ocala v. Rojas

A ruling in Ocala, Florida, has declared that government officials can no longer encourage citizens to pray amid a difficult time in their community. We appealed to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals and presented oral argument in April. We're





fighting back — and will take the case all the way to the Supreme Court if necessary. *Status: Ongoing*

Church-Based Ministry Discriminated Against

The ACLJ has appealed a case to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals defending a church-based ministry in Georgia from unlawful discrimination by local zoning authorities. *Status: Ongoing*

Second-Grader Punished for Talking About Jesus at School

A little girl's public school outrageously



overstepped constitutional bounds — scolding and punishing her, even subjecting her to daily searches for "contraband" Bible tracts

before entering school — because she talked about Jesus with her classmates. We sent a demand letter to the school and are happy to report a resolution to this case that protected the child's First Amendment rights.

Status: Victory

Fighting Cancel Culture at the Supreme Court

California is one of a few radical Left states that tried to require all charities to submit lists of their major donors — information that should not be publicly disclosed (and which the ACLJ would never do). Unsurprisingly, the information was easily hackable, exposing donors to the threat of harassment and retaliation for their political association. The ACLJ filed two amicus briefs in this case; and in a monumental victory, the Supreme Court agreed with us, protecting donors to conservative causes from further harassment for their views — an essential First Amendment value. *Status: Victory*

ACLJ's School Choice Initiative

The ACLJ's School Choice Initiative was created to ensure that every state in the country allows parents to choose the school they believe will provide their student the best education. Under the direction of Jordan Sekulow:

- 1. We are supporting state school choice legislation to ensure every child has equality of opportunity in education, including school vouchers.
- 2. We've filed briefs at the Supreme Court to defend state school-choice laws to equally apply to religious education.

3. We're aggressively working on Capitol Hill to ensure that federal funding in education allows maximum choice for maximum results.

Other Issues at Stake

Buddhist Indoctrination — Young elementary-age public school students are being forced to participate in Buddhist-based meditation called "mindfulness." We've launched a multi-faceted legal campaign including representing parents of these students, sending demand letters and FOIA requests.

Student's Free Speech Denied — A public college student in Wyoming reached out to the ACLJ after her English instructor refused to grade an assignment because she'd written about Jesus. We responded by providing an informational legal memorandum addressing the topic and explaining that school officials generally may not censor student expression. With our resource in hand, the student then challenged the school's decision, advocated for herself and her rights, and, in the end, achieved success!

A historic effort... **DEFENDING PERSECUTED CHRISTIANS AND HUMAN RIGHTS**

The ACLJ is dedicated to defending and protecting human rights around the world, especially those of persecuted Christians. Now more than ever, we are needed as a bold voice for the vulnerable. We have expanded our global efforts to save endangered Christians and will keep speaking out on their behalf through written submissions and oral interventions at the United Nations (U.N.).

ACLJ Expands Global Efforts To Save Persecuted Christians

Christians around the world are in grave danger. But the situation for believers in Afghanistan in particular has become so dangerous, so dire, it has garnered the country a new label: the most dangerous place in the world to be a Christian. Under the hard-fisted Taliban, Afghanistan has displaced North Korea from its top position for the first time in two decades.

The ACLJ is strategically positioned to make a difference — in Afghanistan, in Nigeria, and elsewhere. We are demanding international intervention while holding the Biden Administration accountable for its actions. Christians in many nations are running out of time.



Our international affiliate, the European Centre for Law and Justice (ECLJ), engaged almost 100 times with the U.N., submitting reports and delivering oral interventions detailing the

persecution Christians face on a daily basis and other human rights violations occurring around the globe.

A Christian is killed in Nigeria every two hours.
Yet the Biden State Department chose to remove
Nigeria from the Country of Particular Concern
(CPC) list. We've submitted a Freedom of
Information Act request and also sent a letter to
the State Department asking them to reverse the action and to
protect Nigeria's Christians from targeted violence and abuse.



Two Christian brothers have been sentenced to death in Pakistan for their faith, falsely accused of "blasphemy." The ECLJ and its partner in Pakistan are appealing directly to Pakistan's Supreme Court to have this miscarriage of

justice overturned. We helped save Christian mom Asia Bibi from execution under this same law ... now. we must do it again.

"The deadly violence against Christians must stop now."

This new "most dangerous country" designation should be a wake-up call to the world that innocent Christians in Afghanistan are in very real danger.

President Biden has allowed the Taliban to take over Afghanistan in a catastrophe of epic proportions. Now, our Christian brothers and sisters are facing genocidal persecution. The ACLJ is responding — submitting emergency reports for consideration at the United Nations and filing critical records demands and a lawsuit against the Biden Administration. We are urging international intervention to prevent needless bloodshed and human rights atrocities.

President Biden might want to turn a blind eye, but we cannot. Enough is enough. The deadly violence against Christians must stop now.






Post-*Roe* ... Our Fight in the Battle for LIFE Doesn't Stop

This paramilitary organization has the blood of thousands on its hands, including American troops. It also oversees the export of Iranian weapons and training of Hamas and Hezbollah, two radical groups that have vowed to destroy Israel. We submitted a FOIA request, and the Administration has reportedly backed off its plan to remove the IRGC from the terror list

Taxpayer Funding to Terrorists

The Biden Administration has signaled its desire to resume taxpayer funding to the terrorist-led Palestinian Authority (P.A.),


